

Selected Fix Version Count Validator

Usage Cases

You want to limit the number of selected versions (Fix Versions or Affected Versions).

This condition allows the transition if a Date is reached without having exceed a delay expressed in seconds.

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Add the Validator

Select the **Selected count Affected Version Validator** or **Selected count Fix Version Validator** ...

 Selected count Affected Version Validator 	Validates that the count of selected Affected Version does not exceed a specified limit.
 Selected count Fix Version Validator 	Validates that the count of selected Fix Version does not exceed a specified limit.

Edit and View Parameters

It is possible to specify the limit of selected Version.

Add Parameters To Validator

Add required parameters to the Validator.

Count of Version:

Specify the count of selected Version not to exceed.
