A **Worklog Type Scheme** is described by these below attributes ...

Columns	Description
<i>Id</i>	The <i>Id</i> is auto-generated on creation. It is displayed in order to simplify potential action database side (for support reasons)
<i>Scheme</i>	It displays 2 attributes of the Worklog Type Scheme . <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Its name (A good practice is to respect an unified nomenclature for all your configurations).• a short description
<i>Projects</i>	It lists all projects that are associated to this Worklog Types Scheme .
<i>Issue Types / Configurations</i>	In this columns, are display the different associations between : <ul style="list-style-type: none">• an Issue Type among any available Issue Types and ...• a previously created Worklog Type Configuration (see Manage Worklog Type Configurations).
