### Worklog Types

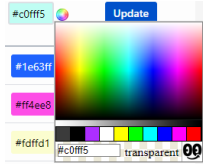
As JIRA Administrator, you define here the different Worklog Types applicable of Log Work action.  
URL Icons can be defined by using a relative path as described in [this documentation page](#), or in absolute path. In such case, the URL will be verified against Whitelist (if enabled).

A **Worklog Type** is described by these below attributes ...


Attributes	Description
Name	The name of the <i>Worklog Type</i> . <i>(Since Worklog Type have been moved under AO, the ability to translate Name is no more available)</i>
Description	The description the <i>Worklog Type</i> . <i>(Since Worklog Type have been moved under AO, the ability translate Description is no more available)</i>

Icon	Path to the icon relative to JIRA's application path. This icon is used for report generation. Some default icons are available (see below table)
Color	A color representing the <i>Worklog Type</i> . This color is used for report generation. 
Order	This attribute stores the order in which <i>Worklog Type</i> will appear in the <i>Worklog Gadget</i> and in <i>JIRA's Log Work</i> page. It is updated when moving the <i>Worklog Type</i> row.


## Create/Update a Worklog Type

You can add your own **Worklog Type** by specifying the different expected attributes, and then clicking on **Add**.

When the Worklog Type is created, you can re-edit it and **Update** the row with relevant modifications.

On Create and Update phases, the unicity of Worklog Types is verified.

## Delete a Worklog Type

<p>When trying to delete a <i>Worklog Type</i>, if it is always used, it will be possible :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>to merge to the selected <i>Worklog Type</i>, without removing the <i>Worklog Type</i>.</li> <li>The deletion will be possible in a second step.</li> <li>to merge and remove the <i>Worklog Type</i> in the same operation</li> <li>only to remove the <i>Worklog Type</i>.</li> </ul>	<h3>Delete Worklog Type: Analysis</h3> <p>Affected Worklogs in projects (5) <input type="text" value="On Project 10000"/></p> <p>Possible actions ...</p> <p> <input type="radio"/> Merge to  <input type="radio"/> Merge to ... and remove Merge to &amp; Remove  <input checked="" type="radio"/> Remove Worklogtype only         </p> <p><b>Delete</b> <b>Cancel</b></p>

## Worklog Type Icons

When creating/editing *Worklog Type*, you can specify any Icon, by using an absolute or based on *contextPath*.











You can use icons already present in Issue Type configuration.

The plugin embeds additional **Worklog Type** icons. To use them, you will have to specify a Icon path with :

- following format : `/download/resources/fr.alkaes.minyaa.jira-plugin-minyaa-time:myaatm-icons/icons/worklogtypes/<IconFileName>`

- where **<IconFileName>** is one of below icons file name

Instead of **Minyaa 3.x**, where **Worklog Type** was based on a extension of the JIRA Constant Manager and where **Minyaa** was able to benefit from the **Constant Translation** Manager, **Minyaa 4.x** has not yet a Translation mechanism.
