A **Worklog Type Configuration** is described by these below attributes ...

Attributes	Description
------------	-------------

<i>Id</i>	The Id is auto-generated on creation. It is displayed in order to simplify potential action database side (for support reasons)
<i>Name</i>	The name of the <i>Worklog Type Configuration</i> . A good practice is to respect an unified nomenclature for all your configurations.
<i>Description</i>	A short description the <i>Worklog Type Configuration</i> .
<i>Configurations</i>	It represents the list of <i>Worklog Types</i> that you have identified as relevant for an <i>Issue Type</i> , related a Project Model.
<i>Schemes</i>	It lists the <i>Worklog Type Schemes</i> that use this Worklog Type Configuration. The displayed scheme name is clickable and redirect to the Worklog Type Scheme Entities page.
