### In Time Spent Panel

... where you will be able to display logged spent time by different criteria.

### Through Workers CustomFields

These 2 customfields will show who is working on your issue. They will too allow you to search for an Issue where a user is/has worked on.

### In Worklog Reports

Few Worklog Reports are provided allowing to aggregate Worklog based on different criteria.
